Dear Mike:

This is to follow up the occasion ~~where you, Noreen,~~ and I met with Mr. Fox and representatives of Patrick Media on September 4, 1991. We walked the area and discussed various theories of why the water was accumulating in front of the berm and how to remove the water. Mr. Fox indicated that he had no objection to having the water run through his backyard if a pipe or culvert were put through the berm.

These are the tentative conclusions I believe we came to.

1. Although Patrick Media had surveys with some elevations, they agreed to obtain further elevations for your review.
2. After you receive the elevations, you would try to determine the source of the water that is gathering in front of the berm.
3. Thereafter, you would make cost estimates of the various possible solutions as you see them.

After we had this meeting, I talked to Mr. Fox briefly and he did indicate that he would be willing to talk about the costs of any solution.
